**NOTE**

Hon'ble Madras High Court Order has passed an Order in W.P. No.14232 of 2017, dated 16-06-2017 inter alia stating:

"22. We, therefore, deem it appropriate to pass an interim order directing the deemed Universities to admit the students provisionally selected and successful in the admission tests /counselling to the vacant seats in order of their merit, subject to the condition that the students shall each deposit Rs.10.00 lakhs at the time of admission towards the annual fee for the first year with CENTAC (third respondent) and subject to the further condition that in the event the fees determined by the Fee Committee that may be constituted by the University Grants Commission (seventh respondent) and Ministry of Human Resource Development (sixth respondent) to study the fee structure of the deemed Universities is higher, they shall pay the differential amount. Needless to mention that those students who have already taken admission by depositing the full fees will, if necessary, be entitled to refund /adjustment of the difference between the fees that might be determined by the Committee and the amount paid by them. Such admission shall be effected within 5 P.M. on 19<sup>th</sup> June 2017 and the students will be allowed to provisionally attend their classes from 20<sup>th</sup> June 2017. Needless to mention that the admission of students pursuant to this interim order shall abide by the result of the writ petition.

23. We are informed that there are some non-clinical courses in the deemed universities for which the fees varies between Rs.3 to 4 Lakhs. In such case, the students will be required to pay the amount of fees charged and not Rs. 10 Lakhs."

***As per this Hon'ble High court of Madras order in W.P. No. 14232 of 2017 dated 16/06/2017, CENTAC has received on 19/06/2017 upto 3.00 P.M, 13 Demand Drafts from the candidates who were provisionally allotted PG Medical seats and the same have been forwarded to the concerned deemed universities. (MGMC – 4 nos. AVMC – 3 nos. SLIMS – 2 nos. VMMC – 4 nos.).***

**Now it is brought to the notice of the candidates that they should seek admission in the deemed universities concerned in order of merit as per the provisional allotment order, against vacant seats.**

**In the event that the candidates are unable to secure admission in their order of merit they may collect their Demand Drafts from the concerned deemed universities.**
